

- **Hebrews 1: 1-3** - In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days He has spoken to us by His Son, Whom He appointed Heir of all things, and through Whom He made the universe. The Son is the Radiance of God's Glory and the Exact Representation of His Being, sustaining all things by His Powerful Word. After He had provided purification for sins, He sat down at the Right Hand of the Majesty in Heaven.
- God speaking in Jesus for Jesus is:
 - God's Self-disclosure;
 - the Mind of God;
 - the One and Only Son.
- Jesus is God in human flesh and form speaking the language of man in understandable terms. The Holy Spirit is the Interpreter as well as He enables us to understand the Scripture.
- God is still doing His creative work. Through faith in Jesus Christ man can now be recreated--spiritually. Compare **John 3:5-7** and **2 Corinthians 5:17**.
- In Jesus we see:
 - the Image of the Invisible God;
 - the Exact Representation of God;
 - the Righteousness of God;
 - the Purity of God;
 - the Character of God;
 - the Mighty Love of God;
 - the Power of God;
 - the Judgement of God.
 - Compare **2 Corinthians 4:4** and **Colossians 1:15-20**
- Jesus is the Mediator. A mediator brings two differing parties together to reach an agreement. In the case of God and man, Jesus represents both sides. Compare 2 Corinthians 5:19 and 1 Timothy 2:5
