Improper Outlook

- + Total Self reliance.
 - Romans 10:3“...and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God.”
- + Self Condemnation.
 - Romans 8:1 - “There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”

The Proper Outlook

- + We now can Accept ourselves our New selves.
 - We are what God Meant us to Be.
 - Colossians 2:9-10 - “For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority.”
 - Romans 8:37 - “But in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.”

 - Philippians 4:13 - “I can do all things through Him who strengthen me.”
 - Colossians 1:29 - “And for this purpose also I labor, striving according to His power, which mightily works within me.”
- + We can now Trust ourselves our New selves.
 - Trusting ourselves involves Fearing God.
 - Proverbs 9:10 - “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.”
 - We are able to Listen to our Hearts and Hear the Lord.
 - Philippians 2:13 - “for it is God who is at work for His good pleasure.”
 - 1 John 3:21 - “Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God,”
 - Colossians 3:15 - “And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.”
 - Psalm 37:4 - “Delight yourself in the Lord; and he will give you the desires of your heart.”
 - We judge all Impressions in the Light of God’s Word.
 - John 8:31-32 - If you abide in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”
 - 1 John 4:1-2; 6 - “Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; We are from God; he who knows God listens to us; he who is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.”

 - 2 Corinthians 5:17 - “Therefore if any man is in Christ , he is a new creature; old things have passed away behold all things have become new.”
 - Hebrews 4:10 - “For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His.”
