

## Prince of Peace” Part 2

“And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.” - Isaiah 9:6

### Evidence of Jesus Christ as our “Prince of Peace” in the New Testament.

- + His Power.
  - Mark 4:39 - “And being aroused, He rebuked the wind and said to the sea, ‘Hush, be still.’ And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm.”
- + His Cross.
  - Colossians 1:19-22 - “For it was the Father’s good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, Having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven. And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds, Yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach.”
- + His Gospel.
  - Acts 10:36 - “The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, preaching Peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all).”
- + His Church.
  - Ephesians 2:14 - “For he Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one, and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall.”
  - Galatians 3:28 - “There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.”
- + His Return.
  - John 14:1-3 - “Let not your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father’s house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself; that where I am there you may be also.”

### The Importance of the Name “Prince of Peace” to us Today.

- + We Have Peace in Life’s Trials.
  - John 14:27 - “Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.”
  - John 16:33 - “these things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world.”
- + We Have Peace in Life’s Maturing Process.
  - 1 Thessalonians 5:23 - “Now may the God of Peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”
- + We Have Peace in Life’s Victories.
  - 1 John 4:4 - “You are from God little children, and have overcome them; because greater is he who is in you than he who is in the world.”
  - Romans 16:20 - “And the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.”
- + We Have Peace in Life’s Relationships.
  - Ephesians 4:1-3 - “I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, entreat you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, With all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing forbearance to one another in love, being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”
