

“Can You Name the Ten Commandments?”

James 2:10-13

Keeping the Commandments.

- + James says if we Break one Law we have Broken them all.
- + Once we give into Temptation and Sin it opens the door to make us more Vulnerable to other Sin.
- + Our Obedience to God can't be on a Selective basis.
- + Our actions show we have no Reverence, Respect or Honor for the Lawgiver God.
- + Verse 11 “For He who said, ‘Do not commit adultery,’ also said, ‘Do not commit murder,’ Now if you do not commit adultery, but do commit murder, you have become a transgressor of the law.”
- + To break any of the Law of God is to break the law of Love.

Being Judged

- + Verse 12 “So speak and so act, as those who are to be judged by the law of liberty.”
- + All will be judged one day by our Character and Conduct.
- + John 8:31-32
 - “If you abide in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free.”
- + True Freedom is not the ability to do whatever we Want to do but the Power to do what is Right.
- + Mercy is the essence of the law of Love.
- + Verse 13
 - “For judgment will be merciless to one who has shown no mercy; mercy triumphs over judgment.”
- + “Mercy” looks not at what the man Deserves but what he Needs.
- + 1 John 3:17-18
 - “But whoever has the world’s goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth.”
- + The practice of Mercy toward others is the evidence that God’s Grace has produced a Transformation in a person’s Heart.
